Stephen Henderson has recently retired and is now Professor Emeritus of Geology at Oxford College of Emory University. Steve attended Indiana University where he earned his B.S. and M.A. degrees in geology. After working as a petroleum geologist in Oklahoma City for several years, he went back to school for his Ph.D at the University of Georgia, specializing in taphonomy, a sub-discipline of paleontology. Because he is responsible for all the course offerings within the geosciences at Oxford College, he has become well-versed in many geologic topics. One of his major interests has been the influence of geology on culture and especially the role of geology and landscape on historical military battles and campaigns.
