## Official Lecture/Field Trip Attendance Record for Professional Development Hours

**Tuesday, May 25, 2021** 

In 2009, Ron Wallace was on an energy committee and the results were published and presented at conferences and at Atlanta Geological Society. The presentation was a review of our sources of energy in the U.S. and where they were being used. He also looked at the state of world energy and predicted energy use to 2035. There was a discussion on environmental issues from all energy sources. Most of the information came from the U.S. Energy Information Administration. This presentation will compare the change in energy sources from the original presentation to more recent data, prior to the downturn caused by the pandemic. There will also be discussion on where the original 2035 predictions were correct and where missed. The current data will be used to predict changes in energy sources to 2050. There will be a short look at the world energy sources and prediction of how it will also change by 2050.

Ron Wallace has a BS degree in Oceanographic Technology from Lamar University and a MS in Geology from University of Kansas. He was employed by Exxon in South Texas and East Texas Production, Offshore Alaska Exploration, and Marketing in Environmental Department. He worked in the Atlanta area for a number of environmental consulting firms, then worked for the Georgia Department of Natural Resources, Environmental Protection Division, and retired as a Program Manager in the Underground Storage Tank Program in 2017. He currently serves as President of the Georgia Section of the American Institute of Professional Geologists (AIPG).
