Atlanta Geological Society Executive Committee Meeting Minutes *August 15, 2024*

Meeting was called to order at 6pm.

Minutes for May 2, 2024 meeting were approved.

Memorial funds for recently passed AGS officers—discussed possibility of establishing fund to recognize recently passed members, Rob White and Ben Bentkowski. It was decided that since families had already designated charities suitable for donations, establishment of an AGS fund was unnecessary.

Bylaws Committee—No progress due to lack of input from committee chairs. John Clarke pointed out that meetings should be convened as there were other issues to be addressed, especially need to be sure that voting procedures are clearly defined in light of 21st century technology and the fact that our membership is now statewide.
